Meeting Minutes

1. Welcome and Introduction

Christos Verikoukis opens the meeting introducing himself as chair of the TC and the other officers. Attendees introduced themselves. Christos introduces CSIM structure.

2. Approval of the Agenda

The agenda is presented to the attendees and approved.

3. Approval of Meeting Minutes ICC 2015 (London, UK)

The committee unanimously approves the minutes of the last CSIM TC meeting at ICC'15.

4. CSIM STATUS

Christos explains CSIM scope and domains of interest. The committee has 387 members. The number of members has increased by 117 since the last meeting. Website and mailing list information has also been presented. Posting on web site is possible with membership. Christos reports that CSIM is also very active in social media, and explains CSIM activities LinkedIn, Twitter and Facebook. The officers will integrate Twitter and Facebook accounts. Petros works on synchronizing social media and email accounts.

Christos presents CSIM volunteers besides the officers.

Petros explains the details on the new web site. In the web site, calendar presents all CSIM events. Comments and suggestions are welcome. It is more dynamic and offers more services. Account synchronization will be ready by the next meeting in Kuala Lumpur.

Christos explains CSIM Awards. Nelson is responsible for the awards. Fabrizio is co-leading the activities regarding awards.

Christos explains standards activities in ComSoc. Stefano reports his activities within ComSoc. Stefano participated in standardization activities on IoT. Stefano is particularly focusing on standardization of SDN in IoT. He chaired a session on software defined sensor networks and IoT in IEEE CSCN in 28-30 October2015 in Tokyo, Japan. Currently contributions are being collected; a whitepaper should be expected regarding standardization activities.

5. Special Interest Groups

Christos presents SIGs. Mission achieved and active SIGs are listed. New SIGs are also presented that are approved in the last meeting in London.

SIG on Optimization of Networking Technologies for the IoT: Nikolaos presented the SIG activities.

SIG on RESONANT: Resource Optimization in Heterogeneous Wireless Access Networks. Nikolaos presented SIG activities.

SIG on UDNs: Marco presented the SIG activities.

5. Newsletter

Burak presents newsletter. The newsletter in December includes information about summer schools by CSIM members, tutorials delivered by CSIM members, reports from active and mission accomplished SIGS, and a report from CAMAD 2015. Newsletter had been emailed to the members through mailing list, and it can also be accessed via website. Next newsletter will be published before ICC 2016.

6. ComSoc Student Competition

Marco explains the student competition. 35 projects were submitted, 9 of them are in the second phase. It is coordinated by Stefano Bregni and Nelson Fonseca. Selection committee consists of 39 members. The projects are evaluated based on several criteria in the first phase. <u>The winner was a CSIM member</u>, <u>Prodromos-Vasilios Mekikis</u>. It is entitled emergency flexible aerial relay nodes for communication recovery and D2D relaying. Prodromos explains the project in a nutshell. A video is also included in the presentation. Broader impacts of the project is "efficient rescue in case of emergency"

8. Reports from GIMS/GITC

Fabrizio updated the committee on the last GITC meeting, and presented the timelines for the upcoming ICC 2016 and Globecom 2016.

9. Reports from TAC

Christos informs the Committee about the status of the Technical Activities Council (TAC). He presets different educational activities: Publicly available platform, online courses and summer school in Trento. IEEE Fellow nominations and DL selections are also presented. Changes in BOG are presented. News

Christos presents best readings opportunity. Volunteers are sought to organize a best readings special issue which spans CSIM interests.

10. Member Support and Evolution

DL applicants are Fabrizio Granelli and Nelson Fonseca. Two new applications have been supported. Commitment for support by CSIM is presented.

CSIM can nominate senior/fellow applicants.

Volunteers for editorial boards are needed.

9. Sponsored Events

The activity of Technical Endorsement commission is presented. An ad-hoc commission composed of Burak Kantarci, Periklis Chatzimisios and Dzmitry Kliazovich evaluates conferences/workshops requesting technical endorsement and keep track of the Committee members in the TPCs. All endorsements proposed by the ad-hoc commission are subject to the approval of the Committee Chair.

The Committee endorsed 14 events in 2015 and on the commission is currently considering new applications for possible endorsement in 2016.

CSIM will also continue to sponsor the CQRM symposium in ICC and Globecom conferences. Furthermore, CAMAD will remain as the flagship event of the committee in the following years too. CAMAD 2016 is going to be organized in Toronto, ON, Canada. Vojislav presents the details of the upcoming venue in Toronto.

Christos informs the Committee about the events sponsored by CSIM, for the forthcoming ICC and Globecom conferences.

13. Next CSIM-TC Meeting

The next TC meeting will take place during ICC 2016 Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.
