Meeting Minutes

1. Welcome and Introduction

Christos Verikoukis opened the meeting introducing himself as chair of the TC and the other officers. Attendees introduced themselves. Christos introduced CSIM structure.

2. Approval of the Agenda

The agenda was presented to the attendees and approved.

3. Approval of Meeting Minutes GC 2017

During this point, Nizar raised a question to Christos about the role of the CSIM advisory board (i.e., whether to be executive in the final decision). After some discussion about this issue it has been decided to scale it to the advisory board of the TC for further clarifications. So, the minutes are approved with the exception that this issue will be clarified from the Advisory Board.

4. CSIM status

Christos explained CSIM scope and domains of interest. The number of members has increased considerably since the last meeting. Christos explained the definition of active member: In order for a committee member to be called active, they have to attend at least 2 of the last 5 committee meetings either physically or remotely.

5. CSIM Web site and Social Media

Website and mailing list information have also been presented by Christos. Posting on web site is possible with membership. Christos reports CSIM activities in social media, and explains CSIM activities LinkedIn, Twitter and Facebook.

6. CSIM Newsletter

Christos presents CSIM newsletter for May 2018. The newsletter includes information about CFP involving CSIM members, upcoming CSIM events, projects by CSIM members, etc. Newsletter had been emailed to the members through mailing list, and it can also be accessed via website. Next newsletter will be published before Globecom 2018.

7. CSIM prizes

Christos explained the CSIM prizes and Shahid asked about the topic of journal awards, and Christos replied that any topic related to CSIM is accepted. Christos said the evaluation committee was selected after receiving the submissions, in order to avoid conflict of interests. The results are

CSIM Journal prize goes to:

- Pietro Marchetta, Valerio Persico, Giuseppe Aceto, Alessio Botta, Antonio Pescapè for their paper titledMeasuring Networks Using IP Options, and
- Haijun Zhang, Site Huang, Chunxiao Jiang, Keping Long, Victor C.M. Leung, and H. Vincent Poor for their paper titled Energy Efficient User Association and Power Allocation in Millimeter Wave Based Ultra Dense Networks with Energy Harvesting Base Stations

A brief presentation related to the second paper was presented.

<u>CSIM conference prize</u> goes to Gaolei Li, Mianxiong Dong, Kaoru Ota, Jun Wu, Jianhua Li, Tianpeng Ye for their paper titled Towards QoE Named Content-Centric Wireless Multimedia Sensor Networks with Mobile Sinks

A brief presentation about the paper was presented.

8. Standards Activities

Christos introduced standards activities in ComSoc. Stefano presented the standardization activities that CSIM is contributing, and he invited members to present their work for standardization.

9. Special Interest Groups (SIGs)

Christos presented SIGs. Active SIGs are expected to report their activities in each issue of CSIM newsletter. Christos encouraged the SIGs to be more active and report to the newsletter regularly.

10. Reports from GIMS/GITC/TAC

Christos updated the committee on the last GITC meeting, and presented the timelines for the upcoming conferences. The assigned chairs for conference symposiums and CAMAD were also presented. Christos commented about TPC nominees procedure that might change and be only allocated by the conference organizers. Double blind reviews is also on the table, and next GITC will tackle this point.

11. Sponsored Events

The activity of Technical Endorsement process is presented. Angelos evaluates conferences/workshops requesting technical endorsement and keeps track of the Committee members in the TPCs. All endorsements proposed by the ad-hoc commission are subject to the approval of the Committee Chair. Christos presented the endorsed events since the last meeting and is currently considering new applications for possible endorsement in 2019. Angelos asked if anyone is interested in endorsement to communicate with him and the chair before starting, to guide in the process.

CSIM will also continue to sponsor the CQRM symposium in ICC and Globecom conferences. Christos presented the number of submissions in CQRM. Furthermore, CAMAD will remain as the flagship event

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of the committee in the following years too. Ashraf asked how many chairs per symposium and Christos said that depends on the TPC chair.

Ashraf asked about Distinguished Lecturers, and Christos said all CSIM DLs are also co-supported from other TCs. Next call will open in September and CSIM can support up to 4 applicants.

12. Nominations Committee

A nominations committee is set up to manage the next election process and propose suitable candidates. Any member active for 6 months is eligible for elections. Nizar asked why 6 months and Christos said this is from PMP and we don't want to change PMP to avoid recertification problems.

13. Next CSIM-TC Meeting

The next TC meeting will take place during CAMAD 2018 in Barcelona, Spain; and elections for secretary position will take place there based on the feedback from the Nominations Committee.

14. Other Business/Adjournment

Nelson suggested to invite external members to brainstorm on new technologies/CFP/... for a 10 minutes talk. Christos said it could be implemented in next CAMAD/Globecom.

The meeting is adjourned at 19.30.
